## CLIMB INTO HISTORY

Pensacola has been home to two Lighthouses. The first was built in 1824 and was the first lighthouse on the US Gulf Coast.

The current lighthouse, was first lit January 1, 1859, and is the tallest on the Gulf of Mexico. For over 150 years, through the Civil War, and natural disasters, the Pensacola Lighthouse has continued to guide ships safely into harbor.

Today it remains an active aid to navigation. Shining 27 miles out to sea, its first order Fresnel lens has a light signature of a flash every 20 seconds.
