Japan entered 1945 battered and besieged. Relentless B-29 bomber raids hammered its cities and reduced war industries to ruins. Isolated by heavy shipping losses, largely caused by American submarine attacks, Japan faced starvation, but Japanese leaders refused to consider surrender. With both sides running out of men and resources, the war seemed poised for a titanic battle in the Japanese home islands. Operation Downfall, the largest amphibious operation ever planned, was scheduled to commence with the invasion of Kyushu on November 1, 1945. Instead, the most destructive war in world history ended with the atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki.
